TRADITIONAL

THE SIX COLOR PRIDE FLAG THAT WAS ADOPTED AFTER THE DEATH OF HARVEY MILK



PHILADELPHIA

DESIGNED IN PHILADELPHIA - ADDING QUEER COMMUNITIES OF COLOR THROUGH ADDED STRIPES



PROGRESS

AN EVOLUTION OF THE PHILADELPHIA PRIDE FLAG BY INCLUDING THE TRANSGENDER COMMUNITY



INTERSEX INCLUSIVE

UPDATED VERSION OF THE FLAG - INCLUDES THE INTERSEX COMMUNITY



QUEER

REPRESENTS ALL ASPECTS OF QUEERNESS - THE LEAST COMMONLY USED FLAG



TWO-SPIRIT

EXCLUSIVE NATIVE AMERICAN FLAG TO EXPRESS DIFFERENT GENDER AND SEXUAL IDENTITIES



LESBIAN

WOMEN AND NON-BINARY PEOPLE WHO ARE ATTRACTED TO WOMEN



MEN LOVING MEN

MEN AND NON-BINARY PEOPLE WHO ARE ATTRACTED TO OTHER MEN



BISEXUAL

HAVING ATTRACTION TO BOTH MEN AND WOMEN



TRANSGENDER

GENDER IDENTITY THAT DIFFERS FROM THE ONE ASSIGNED AT BIRTH



NON-BINARY

GENDER IDENTIFY THAT IS OUTSIDE, FLUCTUATES, OR BETWEEN BINARY - MALE AND FEMALE



PANSEXUAL

WHEN GENDER OR SEX DOES NOT PLAY A ROLE IN ATTRACTION



ASEXUAL

NOT INTERESTED IN SEXUAL RELATIONSHIPS OR EXPERIENCE ATTRACTION



POLYSEXUAL

ATTRACTION TO MULTIPLE GENDERS BUT NOT ALL



GENDER QUEER

UMBRELLA TERM MEANT FOR IDENTITIES THAT ARE NOT CISGENDER OR TYPICAL



GENDERFLUID

WHEN ONES GENDER IDENTITY CHANGES OVERTIME



AROMANTIC

NOT INTERESTED IN ROMANTIC RELATIONSHIPS OR ATTRACTION

FALLS BETWEEN
MASCULINE AND
NON-BINARY



DEMIGENDER

A GROUP OF GENDER
IDENTITIES TYPICALLY
A COMBINATION OF
NON-BINARY AND
ANOTHER IDENTITY



DEMIROMANTIC

ROMANTIC
ATTRACTION ONLY
OCCURS AFTER CLOSE
CONNECTION IS
FORMED



DEMISEXUAL

SEXUAL ATTRACTION
ONLY OCCURRING
ONCE CLOSE
CONNECTION HAS
BEEN FORMED



POLYAMOROUS

ENGAGING IN
MULTIPLE ROMANTIC
RELATIONSHIPS



GENDERFLUID

NOT HAVING A FIXED
GENDER IDENTITY -
CHANGES
DEPENDING ON THE
PERSON



OMNISEXUAL

ATTRACTION TO ALL
GENDERS OR SEXES
WITHOUT REGARDING
A PERSON'S GENDER
OR SEX



INTERSEX

BEING BORN WITH
MALE AND FEMALE
CHARACTERISTICS OR
NEITHER



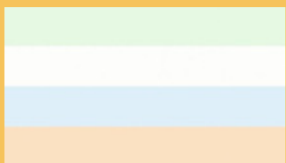
DISABILITY

REPRESENTS THOSE IN
THE COMMUNITY WHO
HAVE DISABILITIES -
VISIBLE OR INVISIBLE



BIGENDER

HAVING TWO
GENDERS BUT NOT
RESTRICTED TO MALE
OR FEMALE



UNLABELED

FLAG FOR THOSE
WHO DO NOT WISH
TO CONFINE
THEMSELVES TO A
LABEL OR IDENTITY



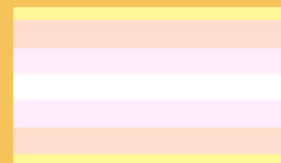
ABROSEXUAL
